Website Terms and Conditions

Terms governing access to and use of the Living Faith Church website and related online services.

Please read this document carefully. By using the website, you acknowledge the terms and practices described here.

1. Acceptance of These Terms

These Website Terms and Conditions (the **Terms**) govern your access to and use of the website operated by Living Faith Church, including its pages, media, forms, donation links, event information, livestreams, and other online features (collectively, the **Site**). By accessing or using the Site, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, do not use the Site.

Living Faith Church may revise these Terms from time to time. Changes become effective when posted with a revised effective date. Continued use of the Site after changes are posted constitutes acceptance of the revised Terms.

2. Church Information and Purpose

The Site is operated for Living Faith Church, located at 9203 Ohio Avenue, Marmet, West Virginia. The Site provides information about the Church's beliefs, ministries, worship services, events, resources, outreach, giving opportunities, and community activities. Site content is offered for general informational, educational, and religious purposes.

3. Eligibility and Appropriate Use

You may use the Site only for lawful purposes and in a manner consistent with these Terms. You agree not to:

- use the Site to violate any applicable law or the rights of another person;
- attempt to gain unauthorized access to the Site, its hosting environment, accounts, forms, databases, or connected services;
- introduce malware, automated scraping tools, harmful code, excessive requests, or other technology that could impair the Site;
- misrepresent your identity, impersonate the Church or another person, or submit false or misleading information;
- harass, threaten, exploit, defame, or publish unlawful, obscene, or infringing material through Site features; or
- copy, republish, sell, or commercially exploit Site content except as expressly permitted by the Church or by law.

The Church may restrict or terminate access, remove submissions, or take other reasonable action when it believes these Terms have been violated or Site security is at risk.

4. Religious and Ministry Content

Sermons, devotionals, teachings, testimonies, prayer resources, pastoral messages, and other ministry content reflect the Church's faith, doctrine, and religious viewpoints. Such content is provided for spiritual encouragement and general religious education. It is not a substitute for individualized professional advice or services.

Prayer requests, pastoral communications, or online ministry interactions do not create a professional counselor-client, physician-patient, attorney-client, or other licensed professional relationship. The Church does not promise a particular spiritual, emotional, physical, financial, or other outcome.

5. Emergency, Medical, Mental Health, Legal, and Financial Disclaimer

The Site is not an emergency service and should not be used for urgent medical, mental health, safety, abuse, or crisis situations. If you or another person may be in immediate danger, call 911 or contact the appropriate emergency service. Information on the Site is not medical, psychological, legal, tax, or financial advice. Seek advice from a qualified professional for your particular circumstances.

6. Events, Programs, and Participation

Event schedules, speakers, locations, programs, ministry offerings, and availability may change or be canceled without notice. Participation in an event, ministry, volunteer opportunity, or activity may be subject to separate registration terms, waivers, safety rules, background checks, parental permissions, or other requirements. Posting an event on the Site does not guarantee admission, availability, or suitability for any individual.

7. Donations and Online Giving

The Site may provide links or embedded tools for charitable contributions. Payment information is generally processed by an independent payment provider and may be subject to that provider's terms and privacy practices. The Church does not guarantee the uninterrupted availability of third-party payment services.

Unless otherwise required by law or expressly stated by the Church, contributions are voluntary and nonrefundable. The Church may apply gifts in accordance with donor restrictions it has expressly accepted; if a designated purpose becomes impracticable, completed, or no longer needed, the Church may use the funds for a related purpose or its general mission to the extent permitted by law. Donors are responsible for consulting their own tax advisers regarding deductibility and recordkeeping. A receipt or acknowledgment is not a guarantee of tax treatment.

If you believe a contribution was made in error or without authorization, promptly contact the Church using the information in Section 18.

8. User Submissions, Prayer Requests, and Communications

The Site may allow you to send messages, prayer requests, event registrations, testimonies, photographs, comments, or other material (collectively, **Submissions**). You are responsible for your Submissions and must have the right to provide them. Do not submit sensitive information that is unnecessary for the stated purpose.

You grant the Church a nonexclusive, royalty-free license to receive, store, reproduce, and use a Submission as reasonably necessary to respond, administer the applicable ministry or event, maintain records, and operate the Site. The Church will not publicly identify or publish a prayer request, testimony, photograph, or similar personal Submission without permission, except where disclosure is required by law or reasonably necessary to address safety, abuse, fraud, or security concerns.

Electronic messages and online forms may not be completely secure or confidential. The Church may be legally or ethically required to report suspected abuse, neglect, threats, or other matters. Do not use the Site as the sole means of communicating urgent or confidential information.

9. Photos, Video, Livestreams, and Recordings

Worship services, events, and ministry activities may be photographed, livestreamed, or recorded. Images or recordings may be displayed on the Site, social media, streaming platforms, promotional materials, or ministry archives. Event-specific notices, consent forms, or release procedures may also apply. Parents and guardians should contact the Church with questions about minors appearing in identifiable media. The Church will consider reasonable removal requests but cannot guarantee removal from third-party shares, downloads, archives, or platforms outside its control.

10. Intellectual Property

Unless otherwise indicated, the Site and its original text, graphics, logos, photographs, videos, audio, sermons, designs, compilations, and other content are owned by or licensed to the Church and are protected by applicable intellectual property laws. You may view, print, or share reasonable portions for personal, noncommercial, church, or educational use if you preserve notices and do not imply endorsement. Any other reproduction, adaptation, distribution, public performance, commercial use, or creation of derivative works requires prior written permission from the rights holder.

11. Third-Party Services and Links

The Site may link to or embed services operated by others, including donation processors, maps, social networks, video and audio platforms, event tools, and ministry resources. The Church does not control and is not responsible for third-party availability, security, content, advertising, terms, or privacy practices. A link or embed does not necessarily constitute endorsement. Use third-party services at your own discretion and review their terms and policies.

12. Copyright Concerns

If you believe material on the Site infringes your copyright or other rights, send a written notice to the address in Section 18 identifying the work, the allegedly infringing material and its location, your contact information, a statement of good-faith belief, and a statement that the information provided is accurate and that you are authorized to act. The Church may remove material while it reviews a claim.

13. Website Availability and Changes

The Church may modify, suspend, discontinue, correct, or restrict any part of the Site at any time. Although the Church strives for accurate and current information, Site content may contain errors, omissions, or outdated information. The Church does not guarantee that the Site will be uninterrupted, secure, error-free, compatible with every device, or free of harmful components.

14. Disclaimer of Warranties

TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THE SITE AND ALL CONTENT ARE PROVIDED ON AN "AS IS" AND "AS AVAILABLE" BASIS, WITHOUT WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF ACCURACY, RELIABILITY, MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, TITLE, OR NON-INFRINGEMENT. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW CERTAIN WARRANTY DISCLAIMERS, SO PARTS OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU.

15. Limitation of Liability

TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, LIVING FAITH CHURCH AND ITS PASTORS, OFFICERS, EMPLOYEES, VOLUNTEERS, CONTRACTORS, AND REPRESENTATIVES WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, EXEMPLARY, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, OR FOR LOSS OF DATA, REVENUE, OPPORTUNITY, OR GOODWILL, ARISING FROM OR RELATED TO THE SITE, THIRD-PARTY SERVICES, OR THESE TERMS. NOTHING IN THESE TERMS EXCLUDES LIABILITY THAT CANNOT LAWFULLY BE EXCLUDED OR LIMITED.

16. Indemnification

To the extent permitted by law, you agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the Church and its pastors, officers, employees, volunteers, contractors, and representatives from claims, liabilities, damages, judgments, losses, costs, and reasonable legal fees arising from your unlawful misuse of the Site, your violation of these Terms, or your infringement of another person's rights. This section does not require indemnification for conduct for which indemnification is prohibited by law.

17. Governing Law; Severability; No Waiver

These Terms are governed by the laws of the State of West Virginia, without regard to conflict-of-law principles. Any legal proceeding concerning the Site or these Terms must be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction serving Kanawha County, West Virginia, unless applicable law requires otherwise. Before filing a non-emergency claim, the parties are encouraged to attempt good-faith informal resolution.

If any provision is held unenforceable, it will be limited or removed only to the minimum extent necessary, and the remaining provisions will remain effective. The Church's failure to enforce a provision is not a waiver. These Terms, together with the Privacy Policy and any feature-specific terms, constitute the agreement concerning use of the Site.
